



Sober Community School Marriage and Family Therapist Intern Opportunity

The San Luis Obispo County Office of Education is seeking a MFT Intern to work in a day treatment substance abuse program for high school students. This position provides a variety of opportunities for quality contact hours.

Hours: Monday – Friday 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on school days (30 hours a week/ 9 months)

Location: Loma Vista Community School (near Cuesta College)

Duties: Group Counseling, Individual Therapy, Parent Outreach

This is a unique opportunity to support a day treatment program for youth who have committed to remain clean and sober. The program uses a *Therapeutic Community* model of treatment. Intern responsibilities include:

- screening and intake
- co-facilitating a one-hour group each day
- individual therapy with students
- developing treatment plans
- communication with parents
- maintaining charts for Drug Medi-Cal

Applicants must be licensed as an intern or eligible for licensure by September, 2008. This is a paid internship. Supervision is offered as part of the experience.
